many busy families. For most kitchen splatters and spills, Thermofoil cabinets can be easily wiped clean with a soft damp cloth.

Slab Wood Door Styles

Slab-style, doors are the most modern of the wood looks, and are often seen in contemporary-style kitchen designs. Other than optional knobs or pulls, the only ornamentation on a slab door is the finish itself— any paint color or striking wood veneer. Choose paint and the

look will be about color. Choose wood veneer and show off the unique grain patterns of natural wood.

Unlike solid wood, these doors are virtually unaffected by changes in temperature and humidity.

Wood is stained, then if desired, distressed. Glaze is hand-applied and rubbed away leaving color collected in crevices unique to each door style.



Aged

Painted or stained wood is randomly dented with special tools to cause stress cracks, and sealed with a clear top coat.



Worn

A blend of rasping, stress cracks, worm holes, dents, and smoothly worn edges. Available on stains with Low Sheen.

Hand-applied glazing and distressing are custom effects and will be slightly different on each application.

PERFORMANCE CONSTRUCTION

ARCHITECTURAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. **Cabinet box** is manufactured with 5/8"-thick, environmentally-friendly, EPP-certified Engineered Furniture Core or All-Plywood panels; dowel-and-glue joinery.
2. **Back panel** is 5/8"-thick, fully-captured, machine-fitted and provides structural integrity and options for installation screws.
3. **Top, bottom, and sides** are flush for easier installation, easier application of footed mouldings and light rails, and a furniture-like appearance.
4. **Finish** for top, bottom and sides – inside and out – is White, Grey or Neutral Woodgrain moisture-resistant melamine. Exposed edges (except inside edges of top stretchers) are edgebanded. Maximum coverage protects against moisture.
5. **Full-width stretchers**, front and rear, provide solid support and a mounting surface for countertops.
6. **Toe-space blocking**, front and rear, for stability.
7. **Shelves** are 3/4"-thick, full-depth, edgebanded, adjustable, and supported with metal shelf clips.
8. **Hinges** are durable steel, fully-concealed, clip-on/off, self-closing, 110°, 6-way-adjustable (for precision door alignment), with a lifetime manufacturer's warranty and soft-close operation.

The drawer box has 5/8"-thick, solid wood on all four sides, dovetail joinery at each corner, and 1/4"-thick, fully-captured bottom, all in natural-finish Birch (standard) or Walnut (upgrade). Soft Close glides allow smooth and silent closing. Glides are a full-extension, tandem, undermount system with a 100-lb. static / 90-lb. dynamic-load rating. Glides have a manufacturer's lifetime warranty.
10. **Metal Drawers and Pull-outs with Soft Close**
Blum Legrabox. Sides are fingerprint-less metal with a stainless steel look. Bottom and back are 5/8"-thick grey melamine. Soft Close glides are a built-in, full-extension, undermount system with 125-lb. static / 110-lb. dynamic-load rating. Glides have a manufacturer's lifetime warranty.

Finished Ends, Finished Interiors, and Panels are color-coordinated with the door finish. Front edges have matching wood or coordinating PVC edgebanding.

Wood Dovetail Drawers are standard on cabinets with all door styles except UltraLux.

Metal Drawers are standard on cabinets with UltraLux door styles and available as an upgrade with all other door styles.

An upgrade to the Metal Drawer. Open the drawer by pressing on the drawer front; eliminate the need for decorative hardware.

CABINET CARE

Your cabinetry is designed to withstand normal, daily household activities and should be treated like fine furniture. Follow these simple recommendations to care for your cabinetry:

WOOD AND EUROTEK CABINETRY

The tough, catalyzed varnish protecting your cabinetry should resist foods, beverages, and household agents normally found in today’s homes.

WOOD, MELAMINE, METAL, THERMOFOIL, AND EUROTEK CABINETRY

Clean cabinet exteriors and interiors using a soft, damp cloth (not a paper towel) and a mild, non-detergent soap (we recommend 100 parts water and 1 part liquid dish soap). Dry immediately. Do not use abrasive soap pads, abrasive cleansers, steel wool, bottled spray cleaners, solvent-based cleaners, or cleaners containing bleach. Wax or polish is not necessary and is not recommended. Excessive moisture can damage the finish. Do not spray cleaner directly on cabinet or allow moisture to seep into seams or joints. Do not leave damp cloths draped over cabinet doors or drawers.

THERMOFOIL CABINETRY

Thermofolds, while very durable, can be damaged by excessive heat. Properly-installed Heat Shields protect cabinets adjacent to ovens, ranges, and dishwashers. As a precaution, open doors and drawers away from an oven during high-temperature, self-cleaning cycles. Also, pull countertop appliances, such as toasters, ovens, grills, or coffee makers, out from under the cabinetry before use. Damage caused by excessive heat is not covered under warranty.

ULTRALUX CABINETRY

The high-gloss surfaces of UltraLux are covered with a protective film from the manufacturer. Remove the film after cabinet installation. To clean, use a micro-fiber cloth or other very soft cloth with a non-abrasive soap or detergent. Do not use paper towels, brushes, scourers, or scrapers. Avoid harsh household cleaners and abrasives such as acetone, chloroform, benzene, ammonia,

thinners, caustic soda, toluene, xylene, dichloromethane, amyl acetate, glacial acetic acid, butyl alcohol, butyl acetate, Cellosolve, cresols/phenols, ethyl acetate, chlorinated solvents, halogenated solvents, methyl alcohol, methyl ethyl ketone, and sink and toilet bowl cleaners. Safely remove any adhesive near the edges with mineral spirits.

REPAIR KIT

Small nicks and scratches that occur during daily use can be repaired using the products in the Touch-up Kit. Follow all instructions and keep all products out of reach of children.

MARKER: Capillary markers are ready to use, just remove the cap. Valve Markers require shaking to mix the contents. Depress the valve to start the flow, careful not to over-flood the felt tip.

FILL STICK: Fill damages with the stick and gently remove excess material by rubbing with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.

This Limited Warranty may be assigned by a builder, contractor or developer to the first owner of a newly constructed dwelling in which the Product was originally installed, provided that dwelling is used by the first owner as a primary or secondary home. Remodelers, landlords, and leasing companies will be considered a Commercial Purchasers (as defined below).

Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph, the warranty periods applicable to the following Product components that were not originally manufactured by Us are as follows:

- Lighting, Electronic, and Powered components: 2 years from the date of original purchase.
- Decorative Hardware: 5 years from the date of original purchase.
- Cabinet Organizers: 5 years from the date of original purchase.

WHAT IS THE WARRANTY PERIOD APPLICABLE TO COMMERCIAL PURCHASERS? If You are a Commercial Purchaser, then the warranty period for Your Product or any components of Your Product is twelve (12) months from the date of purchase. A "Commercial Purchaser" is any Original Purchaser of a Product that is not a Residential Purchaser. Commercial Purchasers include remodelers, landlords, leasing companies, and other private or public businesses that purchase and install the Product in a dwelling that will be sold, leased or used as a rental unit or for any non-residential purposes.

DISCLAIMER OF OTHER WARRANTIES: THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS OUR SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCTS. ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE STRICTLY LIMITED TO THE DURATION OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY APPLICABLE TO THE PRODUCT AS STATED ABOVE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. By way of example but not limitation, the following costs and expenses are not covered by this Limited Warranty: (1) labor costs for the original installation, removal, or reinstallation of the Product, or defective part thereof; (2) labor costs or material charges for the removal, reinstallation, repainting, refinishing or replacement of any other items or building materials which must be removed, replaced, reinstalled, or refinished in order to repair or replace the defective Product or component. For example, costs associated with the following will not be reimbursed: counters, sinks, tiles, flooring, accessories, appliances or plumbing fixtures. When a claim for warpage, joint separation or wood growth is submitted, We may, at our option and after inspection, defer action for up to 12 months to allow the Product to acclimate to the installed environment. Further, We reserve the right to modify or alter any Product design, specifications or materials without obligation to make similar changes to Products previously manufactured or sold by Us.

The repair or replacement remedies offered by Us under this Limited Warranty are contingent on the current Product offerings of styles and construction options within our Product line at the time of a warranty claim is made by You. If a valid warranty claim is filed for an obsolete Product, We reserve the right, at our sole option, to honor its repair or replacement obligations under this Limited Warranty by either: (1) replacing the affected Product or component with a new Product or component of the same or approximate style or color from our current Product line or offerings; or (2) replacing the affected Product or component to achieve a uniform appearance with a similar or comparable product style or approximate color of the originally purchased style. If a Product or components are replaced or repaired, We cannot guarantee an exact match with the finish or appearance of other products or fixtures installed at the Your dwelling. This is due to changes that may occur during the Products' natural aging process, affecting its color and/or grain.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The remedies described above are Your sole and exclusive remedies and our entire liability for any breach of this Limited Warranty. Our total liability shall under no circumstances exceed the actual amount paid by You for the defective product. Further, We shall not under any circumstances be liable for any consequential, indirect, incidental, special or punitive damages or losses, even if this Limited Warranty is deemed to have failed of its essential purpose. Some States do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to You.
